

IMPORTANT BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE

If you have driven down Wellwood Avenue recently, then you have seen the building expansion is moving along now that the steel has been placed! Façade work, masonry, and other exterior work continues, while inside the building, the ADA bathrooms are almost complete, the new elevator is installed, the quiet study room, three new community rooms, and staff office areas have been built, and work on the courtyard on the lower level has begun. Painting, ceiling installations, flooring and other work is occurring as each section of the building approaches its new, completed state.

The building will close to the public on August 15 so we can begin the process of unpacking 1,400 boxes of materials and setting up our new public areas! We anticipate reopening our doors at the end of September, with a public ribbon cutting ceremony to follow in the early fall. Questions?
