

Interagency Collaboration Policy

The Lindenhurst Memorial Library will collaborate with agencies, governmental entities

and organizations on a local, state, or national level as those organizations relate to the

Library's mission, goals and objectives and serve the mutual interests of the Library

and these entities.

Collaboration may entail the use of Library facilities, collections, and/or staff. Any

financial support by other organizations will be reviewed by the Library's Board of

Trustees, whose decision will be guided by Board policy, the By-laws of Lindenhurst

Memorial Library, and the New York State and federal laws.

The Library participates in the Suffolk Share program, a local governmental shared

services plan designed to achieve tax savings through the sharing of services by local

municipal governments.
