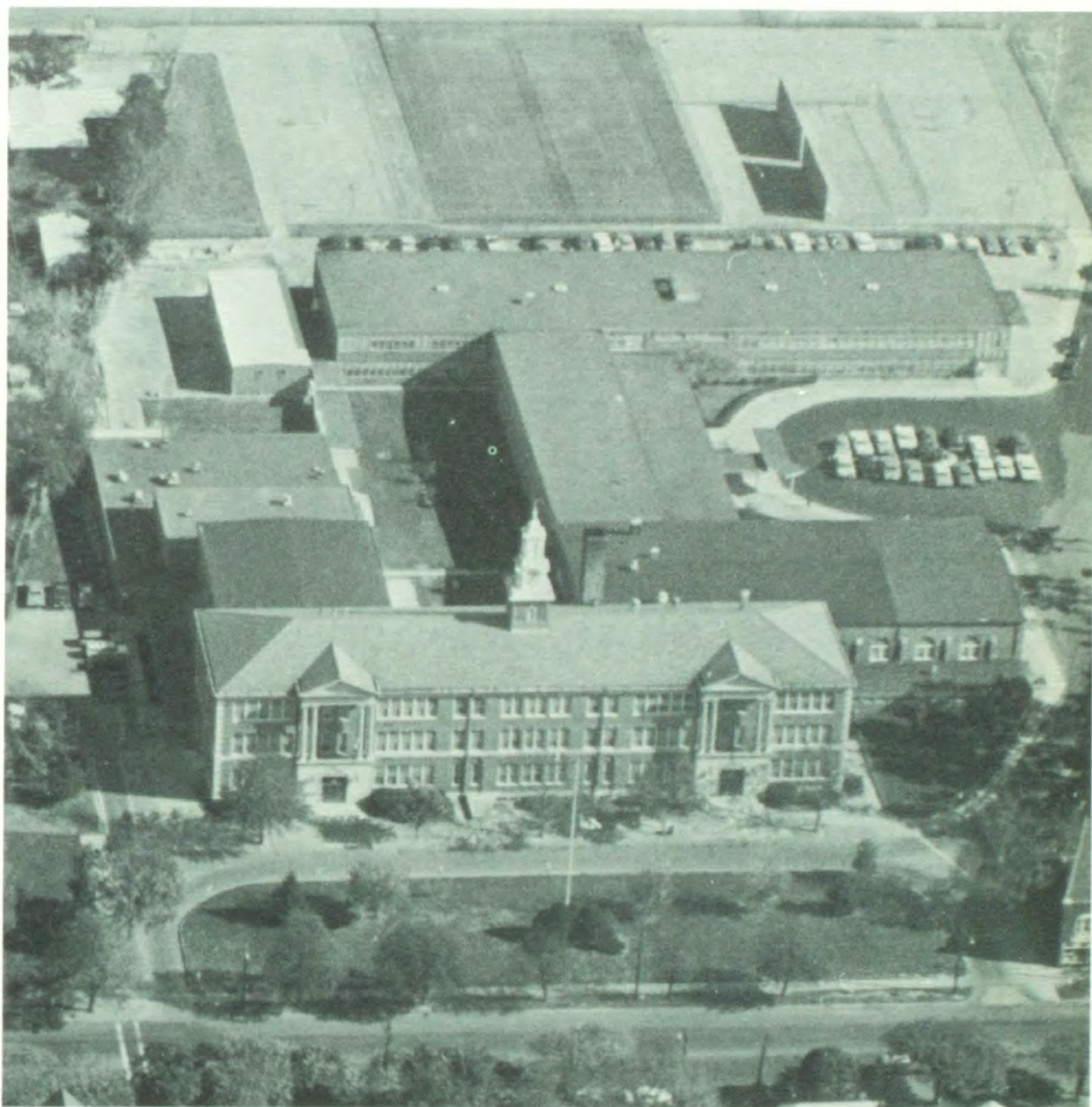

DEDICATION

The desire to be loved and accepted by others is a characteristic of man that is rooted in his social nature. It is a universal desire and certainly cannot be considered contemporary. Man's attachments for others have enriched his life and his concern for others has released him from a preoccupation with his personal problems. However, contemporary man exhibits a greater tendency to desire acceptance just for the sake of acceptance and at the loss of his personal dignity.

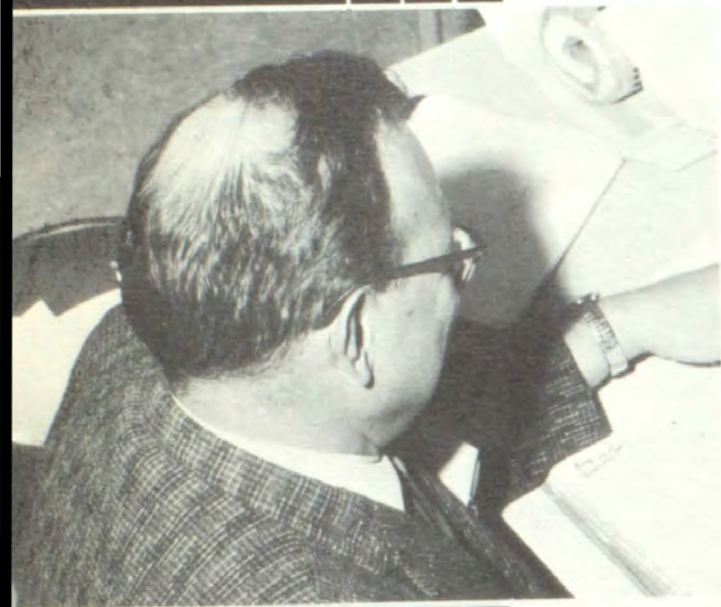
Although companionship is a necessary fulfillment of man's social nature, it sometimes never materializes because of a personal inhibition. This need for acceptance can then become so pressing that a man may be willing to be assimilated by a group in return for a sense of belonging. He must consequently regulate his behavior and beliefs to correspond to the standards set by the group leaders in order to be considered for membership.

But conformity, he eventually discovers, is not the solution. For in conforming he has permitted the group to slowly dissolve his individuality and destroy his identity. Attachments formed with others within the group are meaningless; nothing can be gained by an exchange of ideas between two people who mirror one another in thought and belief. A friendship with anyone outside the group is transitory. It lasts only until the person outside the group discovers that this person he calls a friend does not really exist; the conformist has been molded in the image of the group. His non-conformist friend cannot consider anything the conformist says or does as an expression of his own will, but rather an expression of the group that dictates his actions. Therefore, a conformist loses in two ways; he loses his identity and as a result, he loses any opportunity for real companionship.

The mature individual recognizes the need for companionship, but rejects the contemporary trend to subordinate identity to insure acceptance. He realizes that his most important asset is his personal dignity. Accordingly, he values individuality in himself and in others. His friendships are based upon mutual respect for the beliefs of the other person. When a relationship threatens to stifle self-expression, he realizes that it should be dissolved. Individuality is especially difficult to maintain when others are being assimilated into one or another group. However, individuality is necessarily the prerequisite for valuable exchanges between distinct personalities. Only those attachments rooted in the principle of the dignity of the individual satisfy the social need in man's nature without sacrificing the man himself.
