Eileen Larkin, the "Irish Leprechaun," who died recently, brought joy and enthusiasm to more than 15,000 students in Lindenhurst in her 35 plus years as a physical educator, according to a school spokesman who added that she touched the lives of thousands of people in a variety of ways.

As a young teacher in the early fifties, Ms. Larkin recognized the importance of fitness and activities for young people. Applying her Cortland technique, she was innovative in designing and supervising modern physical education classes and a strong intramural program. From these early beginnings evolved after school playday events which led to the present day expanded interscholastic program.

Ms. Larkin introduced the concept of a Girls Leaders Club to assist in physical education classes and created an activity which provided young ladies with an opportunity to develop leadership skills, gain self-confidence, and receive acknowledgement from their classmates. Will anyone ever forget the white gym suits and green vests?

Coaching was her first love and it was through her dedication, unselfish devotion and personal charisma that many athletes profited. Among her many accomplishments, Ms. Larkin coached champions in Field Hockey and Volley ball, as well as successful programs in Track and Field, Softball and Basketball.

A pioneer in women's programs, Ms. Larkin also spearheaded several ideals. Among these were equal pay for women coaches, Suffolk County Gold Key and other award presentations for athletes, equal facility utilization and peer recognition.

She has been a highly regarded and revered member of the faculty at Lindenhurst and has successfully oriented colleagues to the "Larkin System" of fair play, fair treatment, and respect for others. Her Irish wit and sense of humor have endeared her to everyone who has met her and Ms. Larkin will be dearly missed by all she has touched.

A scholarship in her name will be awarded each June to a senior who will become a future educator, who demonstrates active participation and gives an all out effort in every activity, possesses a keen sense of humor, shows respect for others in a caring way, and is the embodiment of spirit and sportsmanship.
