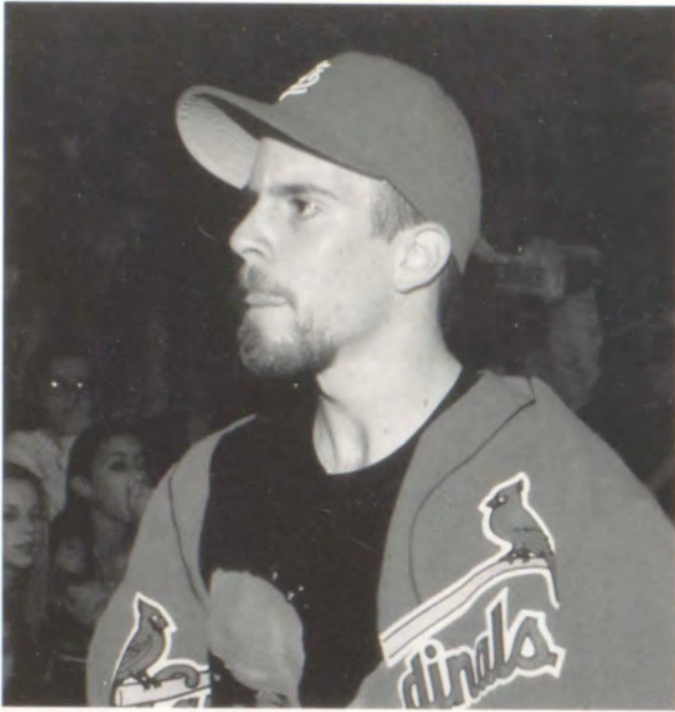

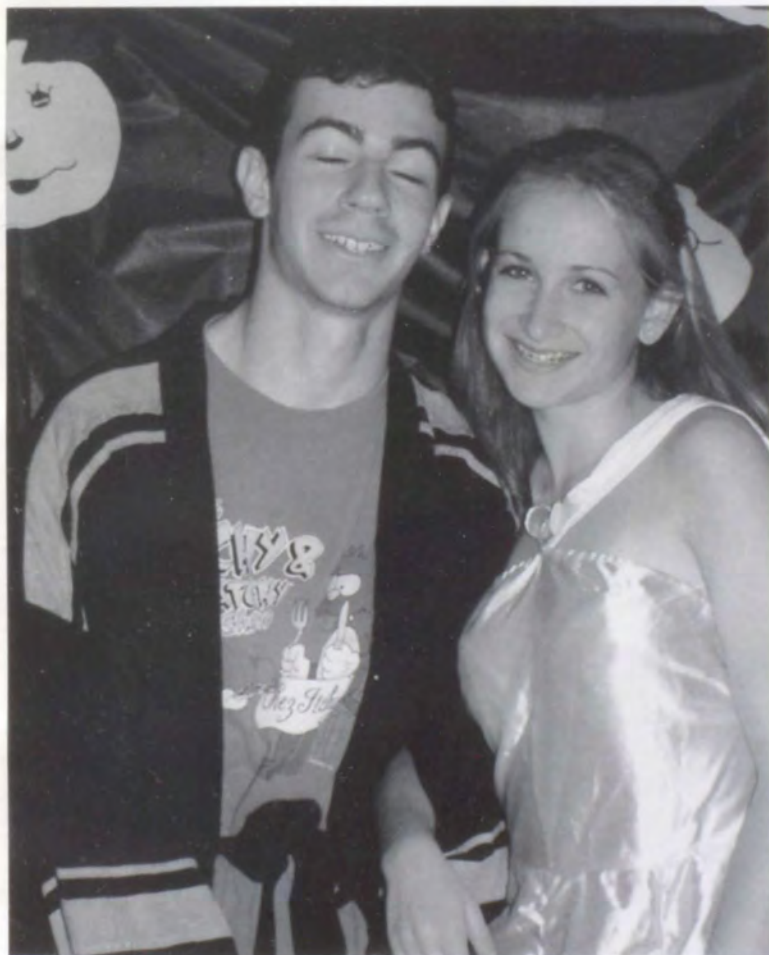

and draw out our thoughts. They teach us to have an opinion and think for ourselves.

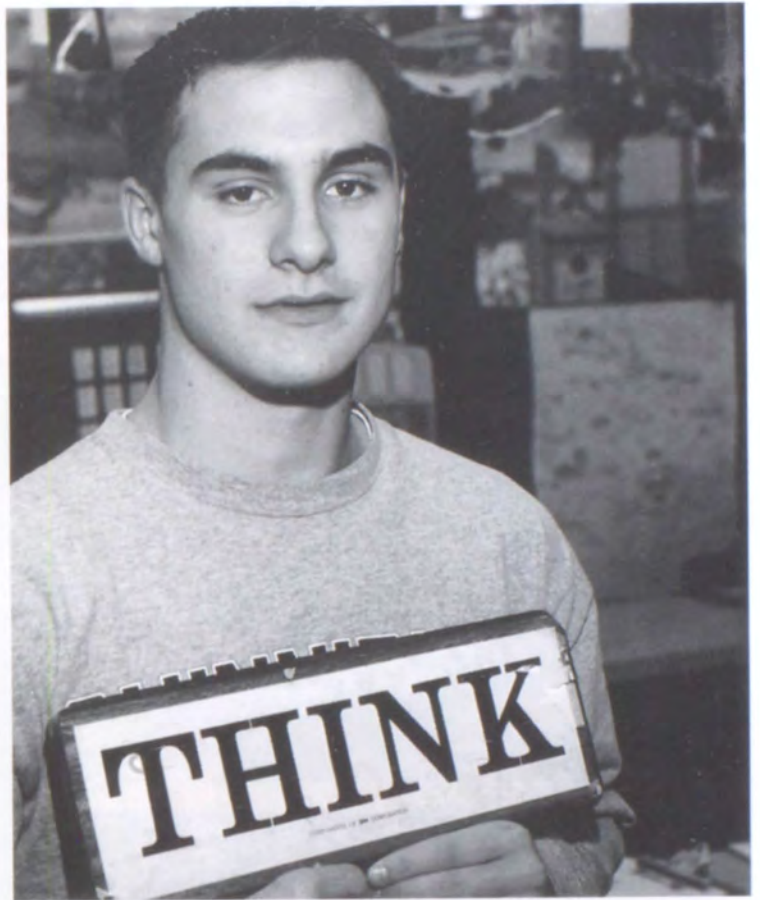

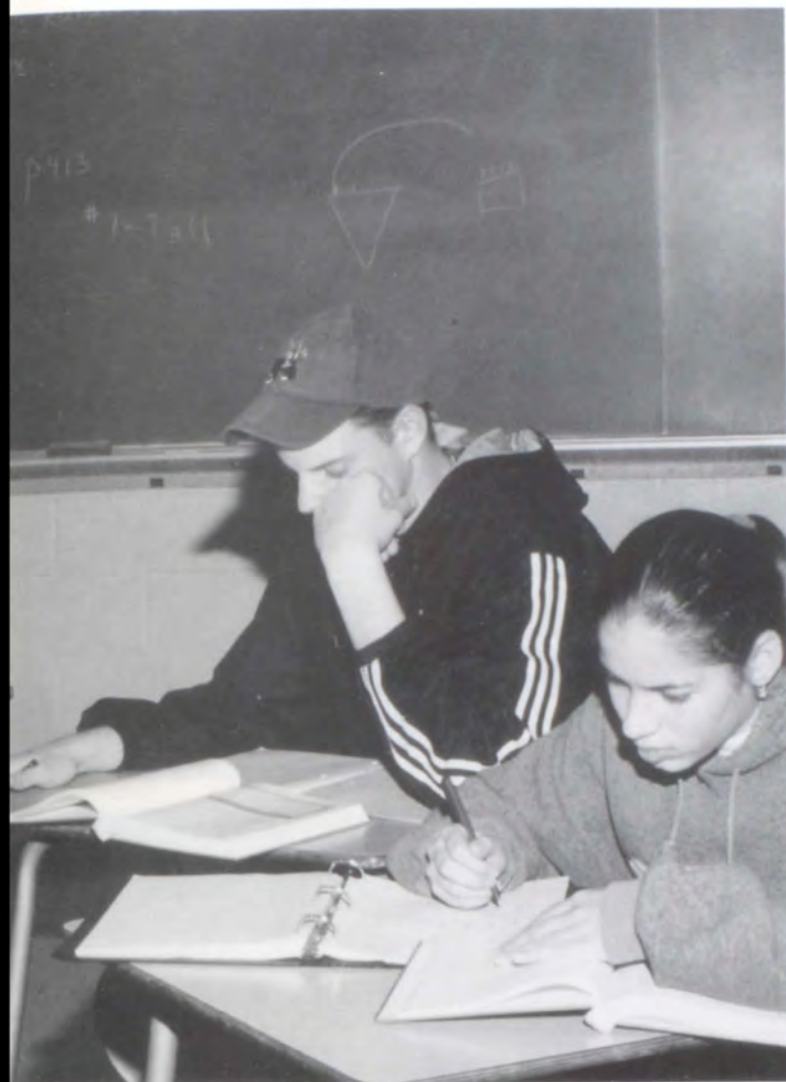

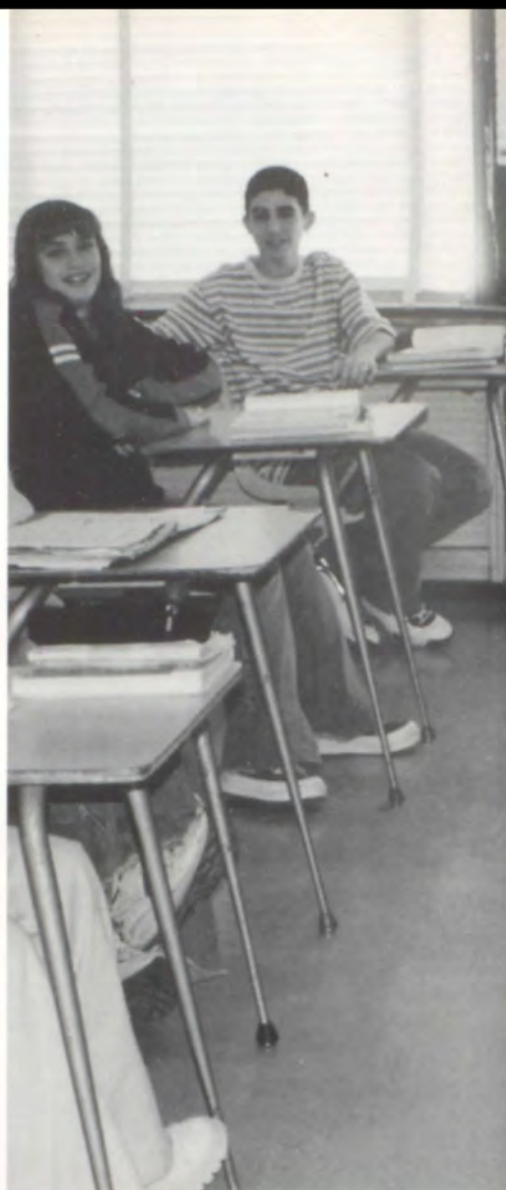

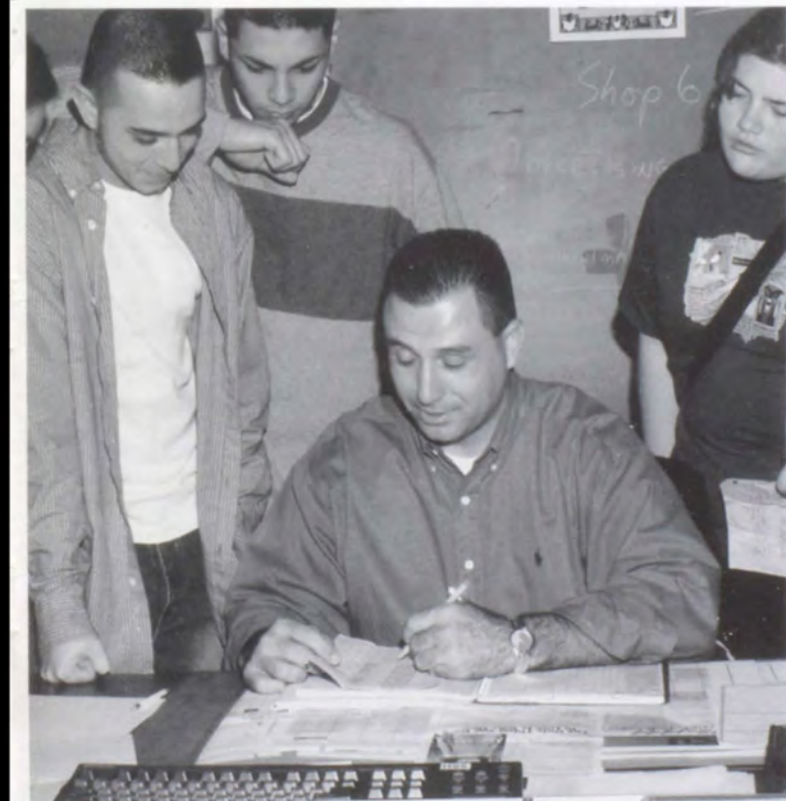

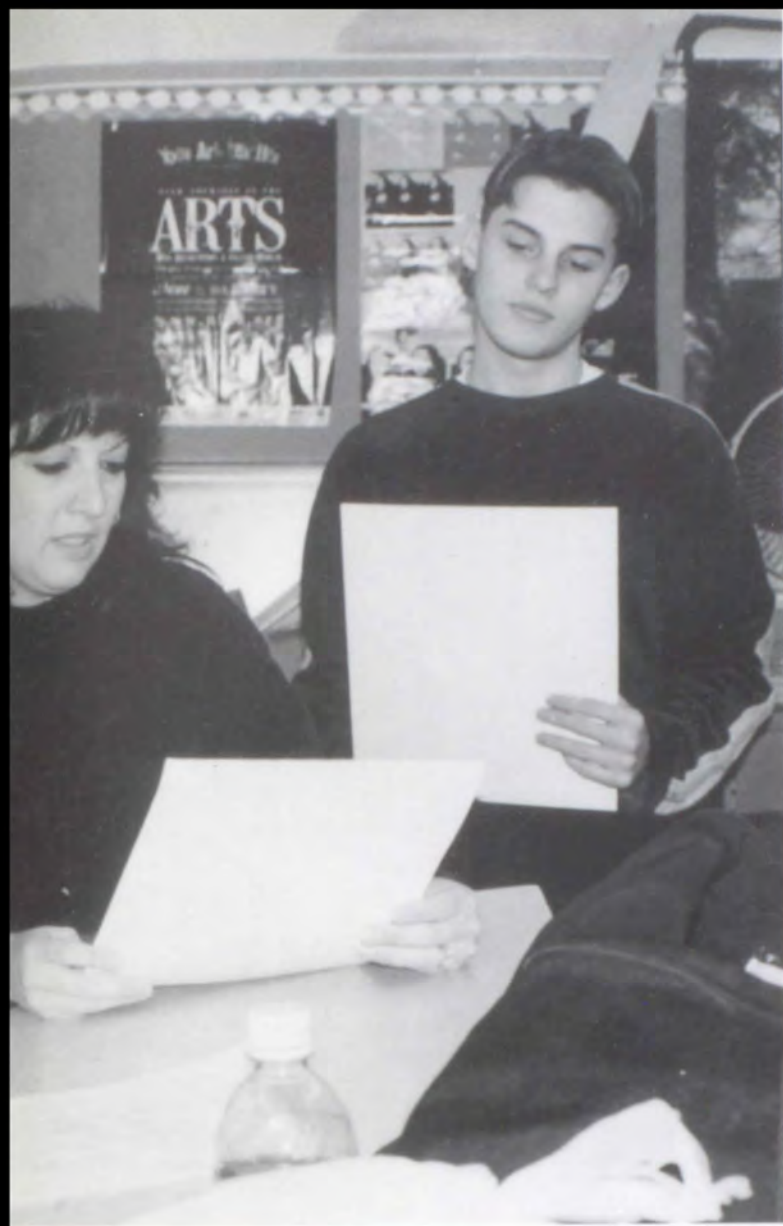

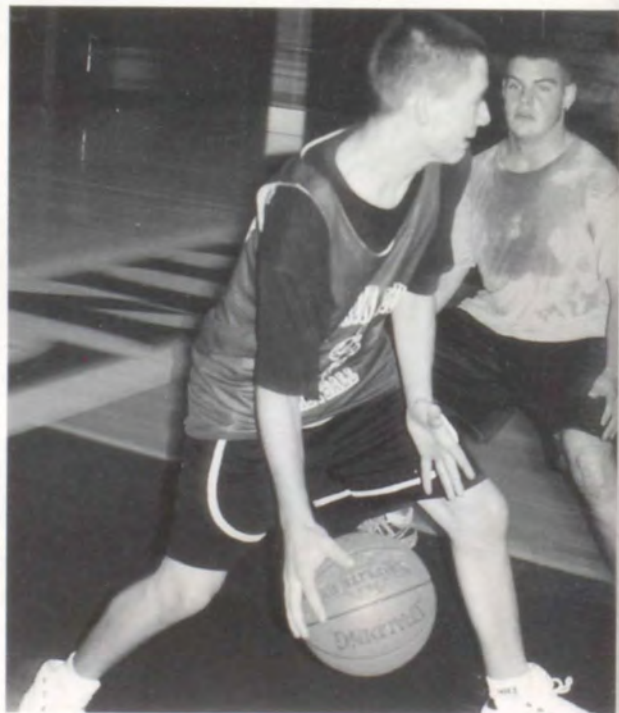

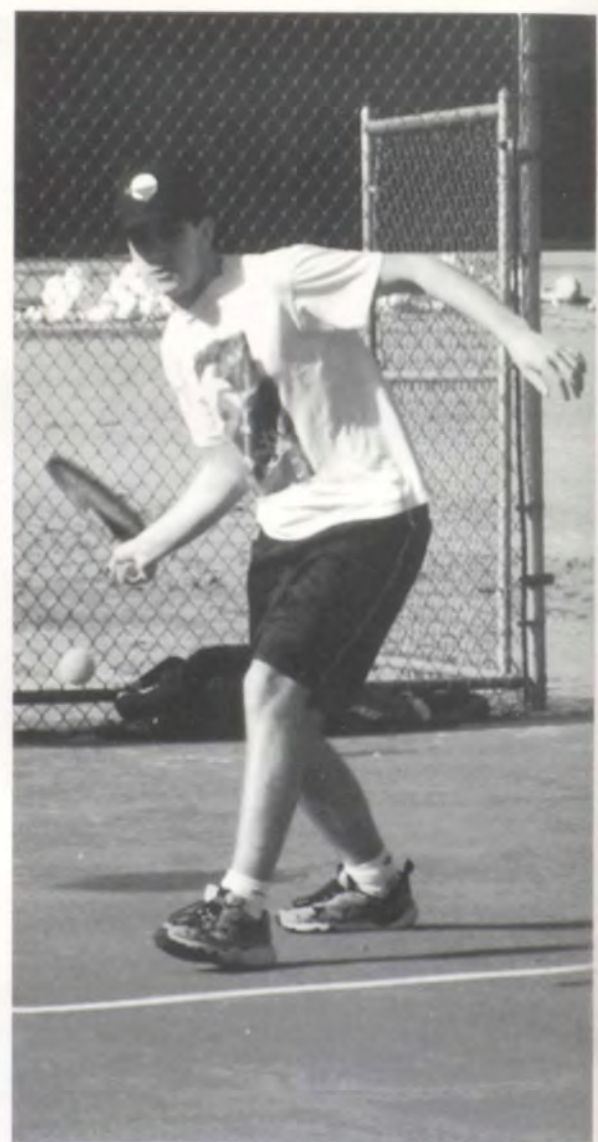
